How to Enter?

- Login or create an account: If you're new to the IWC or need a quick refresh, start by logging in or creating an account <u>here</u>. Please do not set up a new account if you know you have on, we will assist you in locating it.
- Fill out the wine entry form: In your account, you'll find the wine entry form. To assist you, we've compiled a checklist of mandatory data required for each wine. Completing this form accurately is crucial for a smooth entry process.
- Submit your entries: After filling out the form, proceed to payment. You can choose to pay via credit card or request an invoice at checkout.
- **Prepare your samples:** Each wine entry requires four bottles. Make sure you've securely packaged your samples for safe transit.
- Labelling and shipping: Print the IWC barcode delivery label and airway bill (emailed to you with your entry confirmation). Write the number of bottles in each box on the delivery label, then attach both the label and airway bill to the box. Ship your samples using one of the following methods: Private Courier, Hellman Consolidated Shipping or via your UK Importer.

Timeline & Pricing

At the International Wine Challenge, we believe in offering a fair and accessible platform for all wine producers. Here's a breakdown of our entry prices with no hidden fees: **Online entry per wine (no hidden fees) £170 + VAT*** Discovery Tasting per wine (additional to entry fee) £90 + VAT* Consolidated shipping per entry (Old World) £60 + VAT* Consolidated shipping per entry (New World) £68 + VAT*

Shipping offer: Enter 3 wines delivered in one box* and receive £5 discount per item on shipping. *send 3x4 bottle entries in a single box of 12 bottles. Multiple boxes will be recharged at full price.

Enter your wines by August 22nd 2025 using code IWCEARLYBIRD to receive a 5% discount.

European companies with a valid VAT registration number do not have to pay UK VAT. Countries outside the EU do not pay UK VAT.
